On Tuesday 8th February, 2022, Birmingham City Council adopted a revised syllabus for Religious Education, to be taught in schools from September 2022. The new syllabus continues to use 24 slightly revised dispositions as a starting point for Religious Education. There is new inclusivity of non-religious world views and a new dimension of learning, 'learning to discern'.

This web site, and its resources for teaching Religious Education, will no longer be completely compliant after July, 2022. During the next few weeks, Faith Makes A Difference customers will be contacted about training in preparation to teach the revised syllabus.

Whilst some of the existing lesson plans will continue to be of use with the 2022 syllabus, we advise schools not to purchase resources from this web site, but to await the publication of the revised resources. The current syllabus and its resources should continue to be used until July 2022.

This website will be closed down from March 2022. The SACRE helpline will remain open on 0121 661 6408. When the web address for the replacement resources is announced, it will be posted on the news pages here, and in the short term, customers will be redirected to the new website.
