The New2RE programme has been running for 6 years and is a grant funded programme of support for new secondary teachers of RE. The programme has been revised this year and now offers the following benefits in addition to those you receive as part of your membership of NATRE at no extra cost.

MEMBERSHIP: New2RE is now part of ECT membership of NATRE. This means joiners to the programme will all be personal members of NATRE and will either pay for their own heavily subsidised subscription (just £4.83 per month via DD) or have it paid for by their school.
